Application: Our moms are special because they many times care a lot about teaching us about Jesus. This is a great way to thank moms for all they do in telling us and showing us who Jesus is. (P.S. please disregard the “fortune teller” phrase on the instructions.)

5) Learning Activity – Mother May I



How to Play at Home: Everyone stands in a line across the back of the room. A leader is chosen to stand at the front of the room and give each person individual instructions. For instance, the leader may say, “_____ (insert person’s name), take five giant steps.” The person addressed must ask, “Mother, may I?” When permission is granted, the instructions are carried out. The object of the game is to get to the leader at the front of the room first. If a person forgets to ask permission or does not carry out the instructions, they are out.

How to Play Online with Friends: Everyone must have a sheet of paper, and must draw a stick-figure at one of the short ends of the paper. Then, they must start at the other end of the paper. A leader is chosen from the online group. The leader must give each person individual instructions. For instance, the leader may say, “_____ (insert person’s name), make 5 “x’s” toward the stick-figure.” The person addressed must ask, “Mother, may I?” When permission is granted, the instructions are carried out. The object of the game is to get to the stick figure first. If a person forgets to ask permission or does not carry out the instructions, they are out.

Application: In this game, the leader is telling others how to follow the leader’s instructions and be completely obedient to the leader. Likewise, when we are being obedient to Jesus in our actions, people will take notice and may want to know how they can follow Jesus too!
