BIG IDEAS:	God uses imperfect people to be disciple-makers.
BIBLE BASIS:	Peter's Life in the New Testament & Acts 4:1-12
KEY VERSE:	"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations'" Matthew 28:19

2) Read the passage (Acts 4:1-12)

Younger & Older Kids: You might want to use a Children's Bible with pictures or a Bible Storybook to read about this account, in order to keep their interest and help them best understand what happened in this passage.

<u>Older Kids:</u> I would recommend taking turns and letting each person in the family read part of the passage.

Our Digging Deeper Questions are provided with varying levels of difficult, coded by color. Feel free to pick and choose whichever discussion questions fit your family best!

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4) Craft – Rocks of Faith



Supplies:

- Rock (any rock, but smooth rocks work best)
- Paint or markers
- Water-proofing spray

Directions:

Peter's name means "Rock." So, today we're decorating rocks to remind us how Jesus said He would build His church upon the rock, Peter. Decorate your rock with a picture that reminds you of Jesus, or something Jesus did or said. You







could use your favorite verse from the Bible too, to put on the rock. Then, if you have any water-proofing spray, you can spray your rock. After it dries, you can put it outside in your yard to remind others about Jesus too!
