## Philip

**BIG IDEAS:** Share Jesus with the people God puts in your path.

**BIBLE BASIS:** Acts 8:4-40

**KEY VERSE:** “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations...” Matthew 28:19

## Worship Time Together

Take some time to worship together as a family. Sing some of your favorite worship songs together.

**4) Craft – Jesus Chain Letters**



**Supplies:**

- 2 Pieces of Paper
- 2 Envelopes
- Crayons/Markers/Colored Pencils
- Stamp
- Stickers/Stamps (optional)

**Directions:**

1. Think of someone who doesn't know Jesus.



2. Decorate the back of one of the envelopes however you want.
3. On your paper, write the person a note like “Jesus loves you,” and then maybe one of your favorite verses from the Bible. Maybe you could tell the person why this Bible verse is important to you. Then, be sure on the bottom of your letter to write “Pass it on.”
4. Write the same thing on the other sheet of paper (this one is to be “passed on”).
5. Put both sheets of paper and the extra envelope in the decorated envelope. Then, seal it, stamp it and mail it!

Lesson Application: Since Philip shared Jesus with everyone God put in his path, we are practicing doing that too by sending our Jesus chain letter.

## 5) Learning Activity – Roll the Dice



Lesson Application: One thing Philip did really well, was he listened when he came near to the Ethiopian man. We need to learn to be good listeners too, so we will know when people have questions about Jesus. Here’s a fun way to practice being a good listener:

### Supplies:

- 1 Dice

### Directions:

This is meant to be played with more than 1 person. It would be a great game to play at dinnertime with your family. Simply take turns rolling the dice, and whatever the dice lands on, that’s the question you have to answer.

Roll 1: Would you rather eat a bug or drink rotten milk?

Roll 2: Would you rather live at the beach or in the mountains?

Roll 3: Would you rather have 100 snakes or a million bees?

Roll 4: Would you rather go skydiving or snorkeling in the ocean?
