BIG IDEAS: Jesus is Coming Back.

BIBLE BASIS: John 14:2-3

KEY VERSE: "In My Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I

would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am."

2) Read the passage (John 14:2-3)

Our Digging Deeper Questions are provided with varying levels of difficult, coded by color. Feel free to pick and choose whichever discussion questions fit your family best!


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4) Craft – Watching & Waiting Clock



Supplies:

- Paper
- Number cut-outs
- 1 pipe-cleaner
- 1 brass grommet
- 2 googly eyes
- scissors

Directions:

- 1. Have your child color the number cut-outs, and the clock-face too, if they like.
- 2. Cut out the numbers, and glue them in place on the clock face.
- 3. Twist the pipe-cleaner around the grommet to make the big and little hands.
- 4. Punch the grommet through the middle of the clock face.
- 5. Glue the googly eyes on the clock face.
- 6. Have your child write Mark 13:32 somewhere on their clock.

<u>Lesson Application</u>: The clock reminds us that we don't know when Jesus is coming back, but we should always be ready. Being ready means knowing Jesus and following Him.

5) Learning Activity – The Waiting Game

<u>Introduction</u>: This is a fun game to play to teach your kids they can do while they're waiting for something they really want.

Supplies:

 A treat that your child likes (a few marshmallows, a few pieces of candy, or a cookie)





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Directions:

Put a few pieces of the treat in front of your children and let tell them they can have the treat now, or if they can wait for 10 minutes, they'll get double the amount of treats. To help the time go by faster, have them help you with something simple around the house (like folding laundry, dusting or putting dishes away.) Then, once the 10 minutes are up, if the child was able to wait that long, give them double the amount of the treat.

<u>Lesson Application</u>: Just like you did something to help your parents while you were waiting for your treat, there are things we can be doing for Jesus while we are waiting for Him to return. Jesus told us one thing we can be doing is loving others! Who is someone you can love this week while you're waiting for Jesus to come back?
