

CAMPING AT CREATION

TENTS

Our group will be assigned a campsite depending on our group size. At Creation we camp in tents with friends and family in our assigned site. We encourage sharing tents with friends of the same sex and your family. Unless related or a parent is in the tent as well, a boy and girl may not share a tent. Also, no one is permitted to enter anyone else's tent at our site or any other site for any reason. Start talking with friends early to plan your tent!

DINING

In our campsite will be a large food tent where we can gather, play games and eat together. Teams will rotate through preparing the 3 meals a day and cleaning up the meals. We will offer meals from Dinner on the first night through breakfast Sunday. We stop for food on the way up for lunch on the way up and the way back for lunch if you would like to bring money. Everyone will also be assigned one or two bulk food items to bring for the group to share.

TEAMS

Everyone in the group will be assigned to a team for the trip and the teams will takes turns rotating through chores during Creation. The chores include... water duty, meal prep, meal clean up, and trash

ELECTRICITY

The camp sites do not come with outlets or power sources. However, every year we do manage to have a generator on site to run during certain times of day. We keep our site lit at night with lanterns and flashlights. For cellphones, Creation does have several charging stations for public use. If you would like to donate a lantern or generator please let us know!

FREE TIME

Exploring Creation is an incredible time but we also want to make safety a top priority. If you want to leave the site you have to tell your guardian or team leader where you are going. If you leave the site you must be back in time for meals or the curfew so we can check in with you. You also must have at least one other person with you when you leave, three is preferred so if someone gets hurt they aren't left alone. If you leave the site with only one person they must be of the same sex if they are not a relative or you are both over 21 years old.

FACILITIES

Creation has shower houses located throughout the camp grounds for our use. If you would like to have guaranteed hot showers there are Hot Shower Passes to a specific bath house available for \$20. If you would like to have one let me know and I'll add it onto your order. We will also have a port-o-potty specifically for our group's use.

DRESS AND ATTIRE

Creation is a music festival but it is a Christian music festival and modesty is another priority of theirs and ours. Creation temperatures can become very warm but we still ask everyone to be thoughtful about their attire. For ladies we ask you refrain from midriff tops, short-shorts, exposed underwear and having excessive cleavage or bra showing. For the men we ask you to avoid midriff tops, pants that expose boxers or briefs, going shirtless or wearing tank tops that expose the side of your torso. For everyone, swimsuits may be worn to the showers and torsos must be cover by a shirt traveling to and from the shower.

The Dress Code will be laid out more specifically in the Creation Rules and Expectations sheet. The Dress Code is here for respect and modesty but also health and safety.

DEPARTURE

The Sunday before Creation we meet at Davisville Church and begin packing up the trailer with supplies and nonperishable foods. On the day of departure, we all meet at the church in the morning to finish packing up what supplies are left. We aim to leave by noon in so we can set up camp at Creation before it gets dark. We also stop for lunch on the turnpike on the way up if you would like to bring extra money.

We all leave as a in vehicles driven by leaders or parents. If you have a specific request or would like to drive up please email me and we can set everything up. We prefer to take as few cars as possible up so begin thinking about carpooling! We also are looking for someone with a truck to haul the trailer up and back. If you could or know someone who is able to help us out please let me know, it will be much appreciated!

RETURN

The Sunday after Creation our group packs up camp after breakfast and hits the road by 10:00-11:00 am, stopping for lunch on the way to the church. We aim to arrive back at the church no later than 2:00-3:00 pm.

Once we all arrive at the church clean up begins! As a group we unload all of the cars, scrub down the gear, unpack the food, return the tables and chairs, and take our gear back up to the attic. Then we all go home for a well-deserved rest.

REQUIREMENT CHECK LIST

The Permission and Medical Release Form- This form needs to be signed by everybody coming on the trip and their guardian if 18 or younger.

The Bucks Creation Rules and Expectations Sheet- This form must be signed by everyone coming on the trip stating that you understand and will abide by the Rules and Expectations.
